Submitting a Proposal

Proposals are welcome on any subject related to psychoanalytic theory and practice. Papers may reflect clinical, theoretical, philosophical, historical, social or cultural approaches to your topic.

Papers should be no more than 20 minutes long. A further 10 minutes will be allowed for discussion. Sessions of 1½ hours will have space for three papers. There will be concurrent panels to accommodate as many papers as possible. The day will end with a plenary.

Proposals of 300 words (maximum) should include a title and the name of your training organisation. Papers will be selected to reflect the spectrum of orientations and topics suggested by participants.
